



SendGuard Release Notes

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OVERVIEW

Standss is excited to announce the release of SendGuard quarterly updates. This is a new release and contains new features, improvements, and bug fixes.

The key highlights of this release include **closing gaps around shared file attachments, giving administrators finer control over alerts and logging, and strengthening the licensing and activation experience across both add-ins.**

Users of previous versions will need to contact their account manager at Standss (or email sales@standss.com) to upgrade and get their new license information.

The following sections have more information on what's new, what's fixed and updates/deployment.

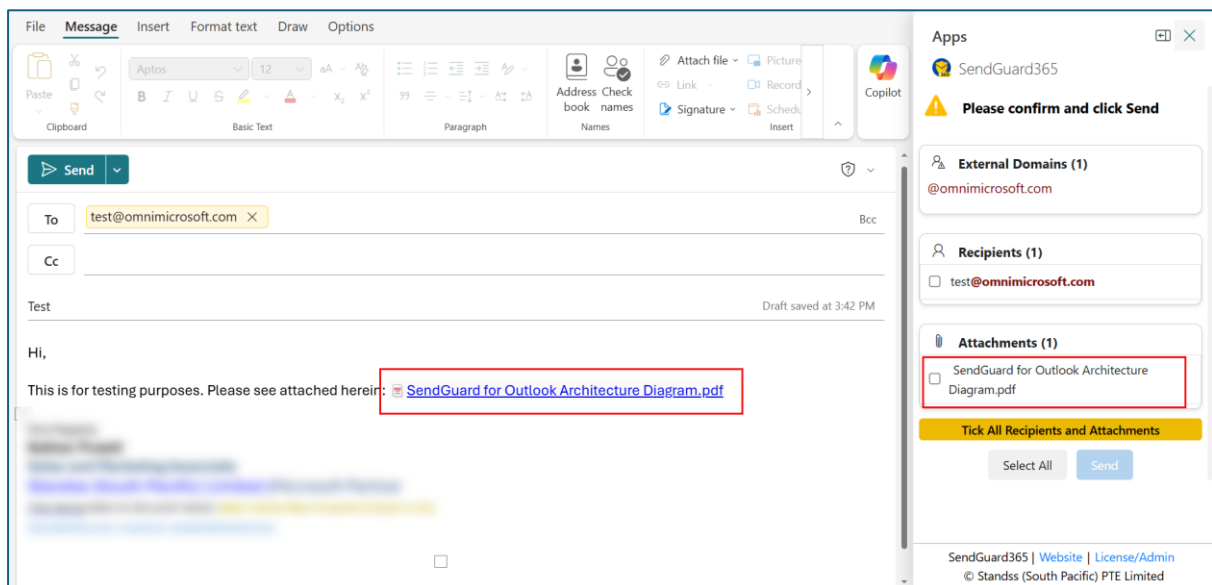
SendGuard365 Add-in

(For New Outlook (Windows & Mac), Outlook Web Access & Legacy Outlook for Mac)

What's New

Improved Support for Linked File Attachments

SendGuard Task pane Addin now supports shared linked files for SendConfirm, DLP, and Attachment Guard conditions. Files shared via OneDrive or SharePoint are now detected as attachments and displayed in the SendGuard task pane for user confirmation, closing a gap where linked files could previously bypass these checks. This feature is not available in the On-Send (legacy) add-in.



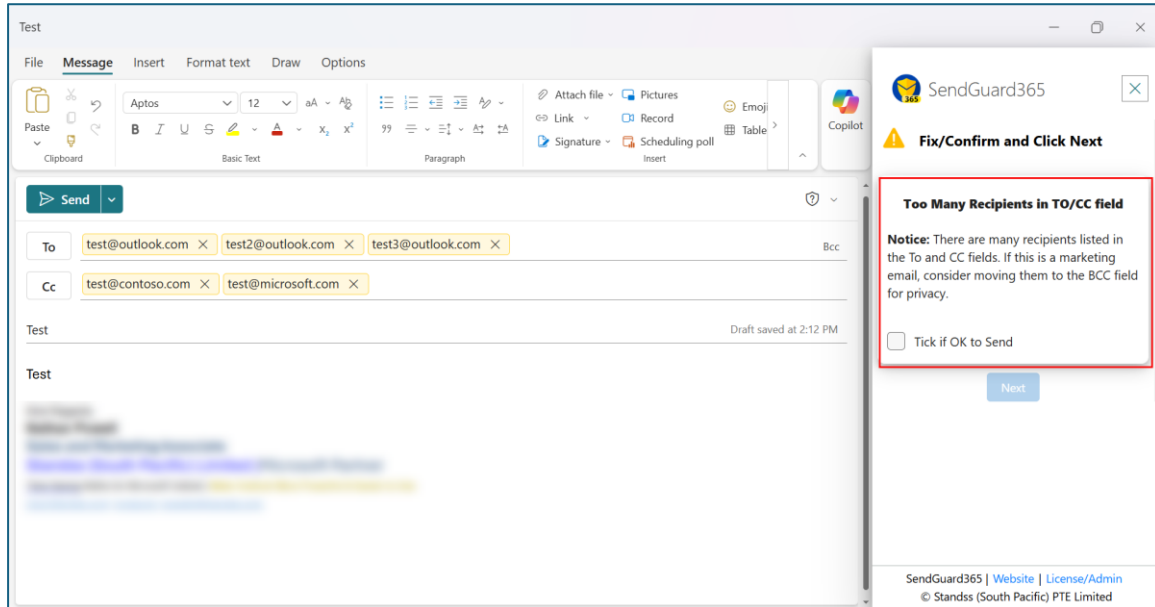
A new configuration setting has also been introduced to control shared link attachment handling. The feature is enabled by default, and administrators can turn it off from the SendGuard Management Console if it isn't required for their organization.

Per-Guard User Action Logging

User action logging can now be enabled separately for each Guard and individual rule. This allows administrators to configure audit and compliance logging based on the specific data they want to capture, rather than applying a single logging setting across the board. All logging settings are managed through the Management Console.

Configurable Recipient Scope for the BCC Reminder Prompt

The prompt that reminds users to move TO/CC recipients to BCC can now be configured to apply based on either all recipients or only external recipients. The selected option determines how the recipient threshold is evaluated and when the user is prompted. This option is currently available in the Open Taskpane add-in only.



Improvements

License Check Optimization

Optimized both server-side and client-side license validation processes to improve performance and reduce the waiting time when users open the add-in.

Security Package Updates

All NuGet packages flagged as vulnerable following recent Microsoft security updates have been updated. These changes improve the overall security posture of the SendGuard365 add-in.

Bugs

Fix: Delay Guard Not Applying Configured Delay

Resolved an issue with the Delay Guard functionality. Previously, if all other Guards were disabled and Delay Guard was explicitly configured to delay emails sent to external recipients, the email was not being delayed. Delay Guard now correctly applies the configured delay settings in this scenario

Fix: "Remind User to Move Recipients to BCC" Prompt Not Triggering Independently

Updated the addin so the BCC reminder prompt now appears whenever the feature is enabled, on its own. Previously, the prompt was only triggered when SendConfirm was also enabled, meaning some customers were not seeing the reminder as expected.

Fix: Classic Outlook Meeting Requests Opening the Task Pane Twice

Resolved an issue in Classic Outlook where sending a meeting request through the SendGuard task pane caused the task pane to open twice. This behaviour was caused by a Microsoft platform issue; as a workaround, the Send button has been removed from the SendGuard task pane for meeting requests. Users now need to manually click Send on the meeting request after SendGuard verification has been completed.

SendGuard COM-Addin (Outlook Classic for Windows)

What's New

Automatic License Detection & Activation

The add-in now automatically detects available licenses when Outlook starts, without the need of customized MSI. If an organization subscription is available and a seat is assigned, the add-in will activate automatically without requiring any user intervention.

Improved Trial & Licensing Experience

Updated Trial & Licensing screens provide clearer information about license status and available options, with improved handling of different licensing scenarios, including organization subscriptions, trials, and expired licenses.

Settings Management Improvements

Settings continue to be applied from the console by default. Administrators can now turn off automatic application of console settings, giving more control over how and when configuration changes take effect. This also resolves an earlier issue where turning off portal settings once required manually re-enabling them for each individual user

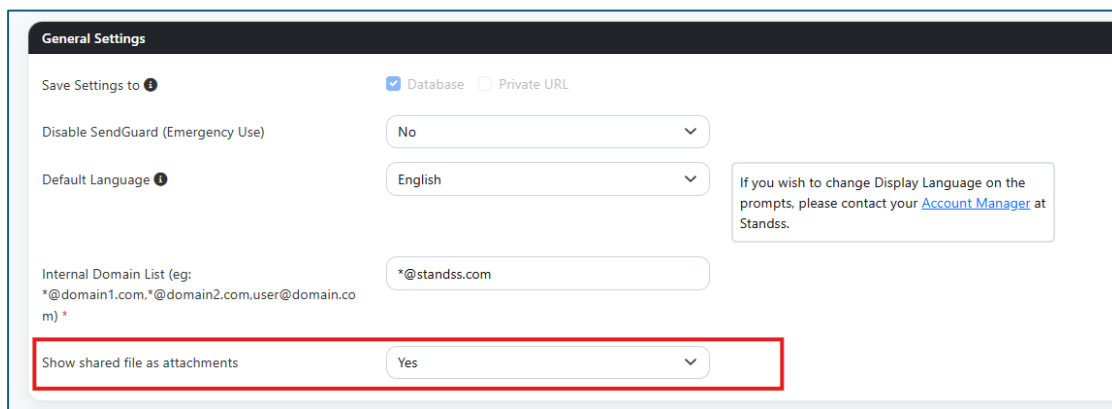
What's New

New Dashboard Layout

The Management Console now has a refreshed layout. All dropdown options have been moved to a left-side panel, making navigation clearer and more intuitive.

Shared Link Attachment Setting Added to the M365 Settings Page

New settings have been added to enable or disable shared link attachments, available on both the SendConfirm Lite settings screen and the Send Guard Settings screen.

Improvements

New Setting to Support Configurable BCC Reminder Scope

A new setting has been introduced in the console to support the SendGuard365 add-in's configurable BCC reminder scope, allowing administrators to choose whether the prompt is evaluated against all recipients or external recipients only.

Improved Send Guard Settings Display

Updated the settings interface to display only the settings applicable to each add-in type, including the Open Taskpane and OnSend add-ins, reducing clutter and minimizing confusion for administrators managing multiple add-in types.

Security Package Updates

All NuGet packages flagged as vulnerable following recent Microsoft security updates have been updated in the Management Console to align with the latest security requirements.
